IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING TRANSPORTATION

Regular transportation to school will be provided each morning during the final exam schedule. Transportation home will be provided on **June 6, 7 and 8 at 11:15 a.m. only**. Transportation home on **June 9 will be at 9:35 a.m. only**. If students do not have a Session #2 exam, they may leave after Session #1 with own transportation. Anyone staying for a makeup session must arrange their own transportation.

Students are reminded that parking during exams is restricted to registered seniors only. Anyone else found to be parking illegally will be ticketed and fines may be imposed. Also be reminded that the streets surrounding the school are posted **no parking** areas and are subject to action by Worcester Township.

During the exam schedule, students are to consult their schedules and are expected to report promptly to exam rooms. Students need to be present only when they have an exam scheduled for that session. For example, when the student does not have a Session #1 exam but does have a Session #2 exam scheduled, then the student may arrive at 9:20 a.m. (with own transportation) in time for Session #2 which will start promptly at 9:30 a.m.. Students who do not have exams scheduled on a given day are excused from school.

Parental contact should be made to the Attendance Office (610-489-5000, ext. 25037) to verify an Excused Absence for scheduled exam session, otherwise the absence will be considered unexcused and the student will receive a zero for their scheduled exam(s).

Students who are in school on exam days but do not have an exam scheduled for a given session are to report to the cafeteria for study hall. All study halls will be in the cafeteria.

Breakfast will be available for purchase in the café from 7:10-10 a.m., Tuesday, June 6 through Thursday, June 8. Breakfast will not be available on Friday, June 9 or Monday, June 12. Lunch will not be available for purchase after June 5. Lunch must be packed and brought if staying for a make-up exam.
