### Mid-Term Exam Information:

- Attend only those exam sessions in which you are scheduled.
  - There is no Vo-tech for part-time students during exams. Only PYAP students attend NMTCC.
  - There are no lunches during exams.
  - If the exam is for a semester course, the test will count 20% of the final grade.
  - If the mid-term is for a year-long course, the test will count 10% of the final grade.
  - If school is closed for any reason (weather), the exam schedule resumes with the next scheduled exam.
